

Host a 2008 Match Racing Clinic

As part of a world wide promotion of match racing, North U is organizing a series of match racing clinics sponsored by WIMRA (Women's International Match Racing Association). The clinics are open to men and women and will be offered through select clubs and fleets across the country. This domestic series will run parallel to WIMRA's world wide schedule of clinics. In 2007 clinics were held in Argentina, Brazil, New Zealand, Slovenia, St. Maarten and Tortola, as well as New York.

The Match Racing Clinic Curriculum was created by Dave Perry and Liz Baylis with assistance from North U. Two formats are available: A full 3 day format, or a 2 plus format (one evening followed by 2 full days).

Host Requirements:

- Boats: 6 if possible. Ideally, 20-27 foot keelboats (crew of 3-5)
(We will be sailing non-spinnaker.)
- Chase boats, buoys, flags.
- Classroom with screen and magnetic board
- Lunches (as part of fee – see below)
- Promotional assistance. (Help spread the word)

Fees:

The fee per student is the sum of the North U fee of \$200 per student plus the Host fee you set (to cover use of boats, fuel, meals and personnel). We can collect a damage deposit with registration if required.
